2. Poems should be typed and must be no longer than 50 lines (excluding title).
3. Any number of poems may be entered on payment of the applicable fee of £5.00 for 1 poem, £8.00 for 2 poems, £10.00 for 3 poems, £12.00 for 4 poems, £14.00 for 5 poems, £16.00 for 7 poems or £22.00 for 10 poems. Cheques and postal orders in GB Pound Sterling only should be made payable to **SPM PUBLICATIONS LTD**
4. Each poem should be on a separate sheet, which should not include the name of the author.
5. The author's name and address should be provided on an accompanying Entry Form or Cover Note.
6. The winners and commended writers will be notified by post or e-mail.
7. All winning and commended poems will appear in [Sentinel Literary Quarterly](#).

9. Poems will not be returned, please do not send your only copy.
10. No changes to entries will be accepted more than 48 hours after submission.
11. We discourage simultaneous submissions. If you enter your poem in this competition while awaiting result of another competition in which it has been entered and suddenly learn the poem has won a prize and you write us to withdraw the poem, we will take it out of the competition but regret we will not refund your entry fee.
12. If you win one of the prizes in this quarter's competition, you will NOT be prohibited from entering next quarter's competition.
13. If on the advice of the judge, the quality of entries is too low to produce worthy prize winners, or any other legitimate reason beyond our control arises which may affect a fair completion or conduct of the competition, we reserve the right to cancel the competition and refund all entry fees immediately by the same method we have been paid.
14. We reserve the right to reapportion the prize money if necessary in the interest of continuity as an alternative to cancellation of the competition.
